



Child Contact Centres

Supporting parents (Bangor and many other dioceses too)

When couples separate or divorce, it can become difficult for the parent who moves out of the family home to maintain a relationship with their child/ren.

Contact centres have been set up to provide a warm, safe, neutral environment where a parent who isn't resident in the family home can talk and play with their child/ren and need not meet their partner. Their aim is to provide short-term help and support towards establishing or maintaining meaningful contact between child and the non-resident parent.



Mothers' Union members help by volunteering at these centres, offering a friendly point of contact to all parents and children who use them.
