We need gifts for children up to about 9-10 at Swinfen, mainly under 5s and 5-7


These are given to prisoners families and other children visiting during Christmas week


The gifts need to be suitable for both boys and girls

Suggested price £2 - £3.00, pound shops, supermarkets and Wilkinsons are good sources


